

Stingray Craft

Supplies needed:

Black and white paper

1 and 1/2 chenille stems, (pipe cleaners)

Google eyes optional

Scissors

Glue

Tape

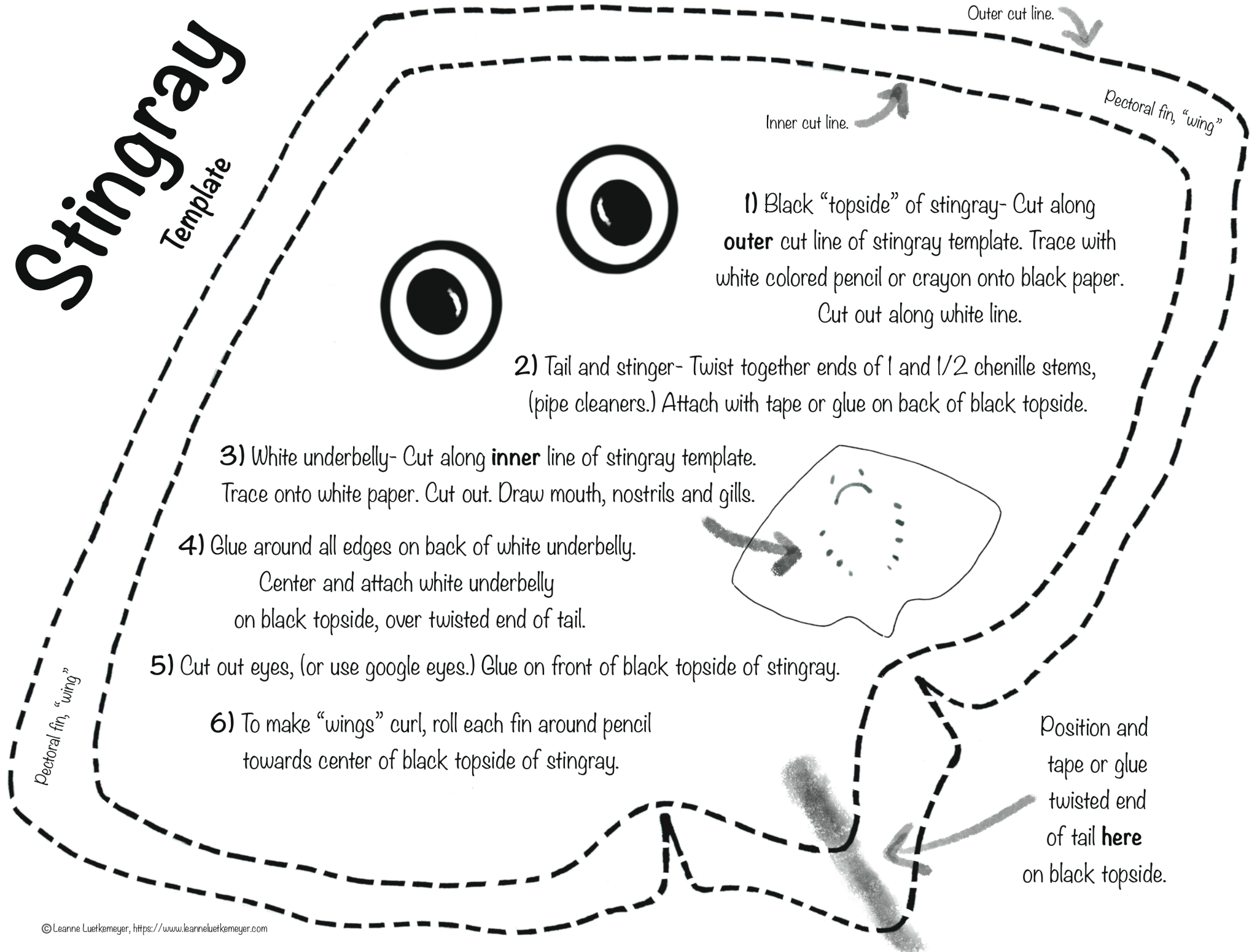
Getting started:

Print Stingray template. Follow instructions on template.



Stingray

Template



1) Black "topside" of stingray- Cut along **outer** cut line of stingray template. Trace with white colored pencil or crayon onto black paper. Cut out along white line.

2) Tail and stinger- Twist together ends of 1 and 1/2 chenille stems, (pipe cleaners.) Attach with tape or glue on back of black topside.

3) White underbelly- Cut along **inner** line of stingray template. Trace onto white paper. Cut out. Draw mouth, nostrils and gills.

4) Glue around all edges on back of white underbelly. Center and attach white underbelly on black topside, over twisted end of tail.

5) Cut out eyes, (or use google eyes.) Glue on front of black topside of stingray.

6) To make "wings" curl, roll each fin around pencil towards center of black topside of stingray.

Position and tape or glue twisted end of tail **here** on black topside.
